SUNDAY SERVICE REFLECTION

Talk about your favorite moment from this week's worship service. What scripture passage, worship song, or sermon quote did you relate to the most? Why?

SCRIPTURE READING

Pray and ask God to illuminate his Word. Then, read the below passage(s) of scripture out loud.

May I never boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, through which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world. Galatians 6:14 NIV

SCRIPTURE REFLECTION

Choose one of the questions below to answer in relation to the above scripture passage(s).

- What did you notice about this passage(s)?
- What did this passage(s) teach you?
- How are you challenged to live differently?
- How can you apply this passage(s) to your day-to-day life?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- Why is it important for an organization, a church, a family, or an individual to set core values?
- Take 10-15 minutes to think about your personal core values. Write them down. What are they? Why did you select them? What kind of person do they position you to be?
- Talk about the implication of what it means for Jesus to not just be your Savior, but your King. Why do you think "Long Live the King" is the first and foremost core value at Cornerstone?

TALK IT OVER WITH KIDS

- What are some things—like honesty or kindness—that are really important to have if you want to be a good person and follower of Jesus?
- Those important things are called values. What are some values that have for yourself?
- The most important value you could ever have is for Jesus to be the King of your life. Why do you think that's the most important value?
