SUNDAY SERVICE REFLECTION

Talk about your favorite moment from this week's worship service. What scripture passage, worship song, or sermon quote did you relate to the most? Why?

SCRIPTURE READING

Pray and ask God to illuminate his Word. Then, read the below passage(s) of scripture out loud.

"My prayer is not for them alone. I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message, that all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us so that the world may believe that you have sent me." John 17:20-21

Choose one of the questions below to answer in relation to the above scripture passage(s).

- What did you notice about this passage(s)?
- What did this passage(s) teach you?
- How are you challenged to live differently?
- How can you apply this passage(s) to your day-to-day life?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- When you're with family and/or friends, do you talk about politics or avoid it? Would you like to change one way or the other? Why?
- Our context tends to determine our political stance. As Rufus Miles said, "Where you stand depends on where you sit." What do you think about that statement? Do you feel you would think different politically if you had a different set of past and current experiences?
- Jesus prays for unity within his Church. How would you describe what that unity looks like?

TALK IT OVER WITH KIDS

- Have you ever had a bad fight with a friend, a sibling, or a cousin? How did you feel to be upset with someone who you are so close to?
- How did you and the friend, sibling, or cousin fix the fight?
- Jesus said one of the most important things in life is that we avoid silly fights with our Christian family—our friends, siblings, and cousins who love Jesus. Why do you think it's so important for us to be unified and not fight with each other?
