Scripture: Proverbs 13:20; I Peter 2:10

Summary: Even Jesus didn't go it alone. Your future is people. If you want to have a "last arrow life," you will have to choose to let go of the people who don't call out your best and move towards the people God brings your direction who speak to your potential and calling. You have to build your tribe.

Talk it Over:

- 1. What impacted you most about the message?
- 2. How do you identify the people are who are foolish for you to have in your tribe?
- 3. How do you identify the wise people?
- 4. Who has God brought you already who could or should be on your team?
- 5. Whose team do you need be on? Who do you need to encourage?
- 6. You ARE a person. But are you a PEOPLE? Why or why not? What do you need to do about it?
- 7. "The healing your soul needs will only come in community." Reflect and discuss.
- 7. Jesus' tribe is the CHURCH. What does that say to you?
