Scripture: II Kings 13:14-19, Acts 20:22-24

Summary: You have no idea who or what hangs in the balance of your decision to either hold back with what God has given you in life or to shoot every arrow you have.

Talk it Over:

1. What impacted you most about the sermon?

2. We've all had moments in life where we didn't say or do something that we know we should have. Describe a specific instance of that happening in your life.

- 3. What caused you to hold back in that situation?
- 3. What does "living life to the full" look like in your relationships? At your work? With your finances?
- 4. Pray and ask God specific arrows for you to shoot this week.

Talk it Over with Kids:

- What is something you want to do, and think you should, but are scared to do?
- What are the risks if you do it?
- What are the costs if you don't do it?
