

## **Talking Points Discussion Guide**

The Last Arrow: Stand Your Ground Sunday, August 23, 2020

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**Scripture:** Matthew 20:28; Mark 3:1-6; John 19:28-29

**Summary:** Opposition comes to everyone. But if you are going to live a life that pleases God and never settles, you will have to stand your ground and keep shooting with the arrows you have been given. There is never a time to stop and say, "I gave enough." If you keep shooting your arrows, risking all the way, opting to live until you have nothing left to give, you will outlast your own life.

## Talk it Over:

- 1. What impacted you most about the message?
- 2. What arrows do you think you may have that no one else can shoot?
- 3. What currently defines you? What do you want to define you?
- 4. What are you willing to die for? Truly?
- 5. How does that compare with what you are willing to make issues over?
- 6. What would the people who know you best say is predictable about you? Does it contribute in any way to a last arrow life?
- 7. How much attention do you pay to your approval ratings? Compared to Jesus?
- 8. What do you know needs to happen next for you to take steps to emptying your quiver?

Live to leave with your quiver empty.

## **Talk it Over with Kids:**

- What is most important to you? What is a big goal you have for your life?
- What do you think you can do that no one else can do quite like you? That is a gift God gave you. How do you think you could use that gift or ability to help others?
- Is it hard for you to do the right thing if other people don't want you to? How can you be brave?
