The Last Arrow | Act like your life depends on it!

Scripture: II Kings 4:1-6; II Timothy 4:1-2

Summary: You will never fulfill your life mission and dream until it becomes urgent. Everyone wants to have a great life and matter in some way. But time is always short. You must become urgent.

Talk it Over:

1. What impacted you most about the message?
2. What were the risks the woman in the story had to take? What convinced her that action on her part was urgent and worth the risk?
3. Where do you want your life story to improve? What arrows do you think you need to shoot but you delay?
4. What risks do you need to take? Why is it not yet urgent to you?
5. How might your life change if you decided to live a last arrow life and become urgent about it?
6. What arrows do you need to shoot before the end of the year?
7. What arrows do you have in your quiver you know God wants you to shoot in this life?

Procrastination and “take it easy” are never compatible with a “last arrow” life.

Talk it Over with Kids:

- Are you a “wait a minute” kid? When you are asked to do something, do you almost always say, “Just a minute”?
- What happens when you wait too long?

- Do you ever say “wait a minute” about things God wants you to do?
- What is something God wants you to do that you should do before school starts?
