SUNDAY SERVICE REFLECTION

Talk about your favorite moment from this week’s worship service. What scripture passage, worship song, or sermon quote did you relate to the most? Why?

SCRIPTURE READING

Pray and ask God to illuminate his Word. Then, read the below passage(s) of scripture out loud.

They came back to Moses and Aaron and the whole Israelite community at Kadesh in the Desert of Paran. There they reported to them and to the whole assembly and showed them the fruit of the land. They gave Moses this account: “We went into the land to which you sent us, and it does flow with milk and honey! Here is its fruit. But the people who live there are powerful, and the cities are fortified and very large.” Then Caleb silenced the people before Moses and said, “We should go up and take possession of the land, for we can certainly do it.” But the men who had gone up with him said, “We can’t attack those people; they are stronger than we are.” Numbers 13:26-28, 30-31 NIV

After this the Lord appointed seventy-two others and sent them two by two ahead of him to every town and place where he was about to go. He told them, “The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few.” Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field. Go! I am sending you out like lambs among wolves. Heal the sick who are there and tell them, “The kingdom of God has come near to you.” Luke 10:1-3, 9 NIV

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- Giants and wolves can cause us to lose focus on what really matters. Talk about a time when you've allowed struggles and opposition to deflect your focus off of God.
- We have access to God's power by staying connected to him. What are some things you can start or continue doing to better connect to God?
- Often, our paralyzing fears in life are because we believe we don't truly have access to God's power. What can you do this week to fight back against that lie from the Enemy?

TALK IT OVER WITH KIDS

- Have you ever been alone? Or thought that you were alone? How did it make you feel?
- God never leaves us by ourselves. How can you remind yourself that God is with you?
- God tells us anything is possible because Jesus is with us. What is something that you can do that you may have been afraid to do before? (e.g. Make a friend, speak up in class, etc.)
