Scripture: 1 Corinthians 1:26 - 31; 2 Corinthians 2:4-7; 2 Corinthians 5:7,

Summary: Through creation, God knew that we were created perfectly for his plan. Our very being was made perfect, not that you are perfect, but your ability to be broken and rely on how perfect God was. This is why we are "Jars of Clay," we can easily be broken for God's power and greatness to be on display. His "surpassing power" gives us everything we need to get through the tough times. Yes, there are times that God's power does not seem to be enough, but it will be. When it is all said and done, not only will His power be enough, but those around will experience God's glory as you embrace your weakness and His power in every situation.
